### **Attendance Requirements:**


- Daily attendance is required. All students must login to the Google Classroom daily and attend scheduled virtual learning sessions.
- Students will receive directions for attending classes through their GMail account and through their Google Classrooms.

### **Academic Expectations:**

- Students are expected to demonstrate polite and respectful behavior when interacting online with staff and other students

- Teachers will post weekly lessons for each course. Teachers will deliver lessons through asynchronous (previously recorded) video and synchronous (live instruction) video.
- Students will also be provided with teacher office hours to call in and get questions answered or to visit with staff and students.
- Students will be expected to meet all learning expectations as if they were present in the classroom.
- Teachers will establish small group and individual instruction for students when needed.
- The State of Washington limits screen time for students. We will assign some independent work for students to complete outside of virtual learning sessions with teachers.
